

IMPORTANT INFORMATION:

In accordance with the current Ontario Legislation, beginning **WEDNESDAY, SEPTEMBER 22nd, 2021**, all patrons 12 years or older must provide proof of vaccination **WHEN DINING INDOORS** at Kingsville Golf Club.

We ask you to please be kind as we navigate these new health and safety requirements. Anyone not complying with proof of vaccination cannot access our Dining Room at Kingsville Golf. This in accordance with Ontario Government Guidelines.

You may experience some delays when you arrive for lunch or dinner because of this verification process. MEMBERS 'FAST PASS OPTION':

For those who are comfortable, you may email a copy of your proof of vaccination to office@kingsvillegolf.com. This will expedite the check in process each time you access the Dining Room.

Proof of vaccination is NOT REQUIRED for PATIO DINING, GOLF, PRACTICE RANGE OR TAKE OUT SERVICE.

Tee Times:

All player names MUST appear on the tee sheet and twosomes will be joined. This is mandatory. Please reserve your cart at the same time as you book your tee time. This will help the staff plan accordingly.

Walk-On Play is not allowed. First priority is given to members with booked tee times. If you are looking for a round, it is best to call the Pro Shop first.

Club Cleaning:

Club cleaning and storage is permitted! If you wish to store your clubs and pull carts with us, please complete a form with the Back Shop staff. Locker rooms and showers will remain closed for the season.

Golf & Pro Shop:

The Pro Shop will be open with a posted maximum capacity to ensure we comply with the social distancing guidelines. Masks are required to enter the Pro Shop. Non-essential retail sales are not permitted. If you would like to place an order for pick up via curbside service, please contact the Pro Shop at 519-733-6561 ext 113.

All carts are thoroughly disinfected and will be sanitized after every round. Our staff is very cognizant of keeping our facility sanitized and our golfers safe.

Masks are not required to while riding together. There is a divider installed between the riders to restrict contact if riders wish to have them rolled down. Any dividers found damaged will be charged to the riders.

On course benches, ball washers, and bunker rakes are now permitted. Water coolers remain off the course.

Please remember to bring water with you to remain hydrated on the course. There is a touchless water refill station located at the Snack Bar. Golfers are not permitted to touch the pins. We have a mechanism on the flagsticks which allows ball retrieval with the use of your putter.

Practice facilities, including the range, are open. Please ensure you're following social distancing.

We must maintain an adequate pace of play as the golf course is packed! Please keep this in mind as we do not want a slow pace of play. If you are falling behind, please pick up and move on to get back on pace.

The golf course is beautiful and we want to keep it that way. We need everyone to be vigilant to ensure ball marks are replaced and divots repaired. This is every golfer's responsibility.

Washrooms:

Washrooms on the course, at the Snack Bar and Pro Shop will be open and available to golfers. They have been thoroughly disinfected and will be sanitized every half hour. Sanitizer spray bottles will be available at all washrooms however, we fully encourage all members to bring their own hand sanitizer.

Food & Beverage:

The Snack Bar and Snack Bar Patio are open to patrons daily, weather permitting, as a first come first served basis. Please wear a mask at all times unless seated.

Our Clubhouse Patio is open daily from 11am to dusk, weather permitting. Reservations and walk-ins are accepted based on seating availability. Please wear a mask at all times unless seated.

The Dining Room will only open with limited capacity on Fridays & Saturdays from 4:00 pm to 8:00 pm.

Reservations are mandatory. The Dining Room will open any day during periods of inclement weather to accommodate our patio patrons. Masks are required inside until seated. There is no limit to the number of people permitted to sit at one table, however, there must be 2 meters (6 feet) of space between each table.

Your contact information is required for 'contact tracing' purposes. You will be provided with a QR code to scan with your mobile device to complete the contract tracing form electronically. A sign-up sheet will be provided by your server in the event that you do not have a mobile device with you.

Our COVID Safety Policy can be reviewed upon request.

There will be significant signage around the facility indicating a variety of guidelines that all golfers must adhere.

Clubhouse:

EXTENDED MASK POLICY:

All Members and Guests of the Club must wear a mask when entering the Golf Shop or Clubhouse. Please note that in accordance with the Reopening Ontario Act, 2020 and Windsor-Essex County Health Unit, the following conditions are exempt from wearing a mask:

- Is a child who is younger than two years of age,
- has a medical condition that inhibits their ability to wear a mask or face covering,
- is unable to put on remove their mask or face covering without the assistance of another person,
- needs to temporarily remove their mask or face covering as may be necessary for the purposes of health and safety,

- is being accommodated in accordance with the *Accessibility for Ontarians with Disabilities Act, 2005*, or
- is being reasonably accommodated in accordance with the *Human Rights Code*.

In the event that a person is unable to wear a mask for any reason, you must practice social distancing.

All patrons **MUST** wear a mask when riding a cart, unless with a member of a single household.
